POINTS

State Finals is worth a total of 40 points per event. Points are earned with 3 goes/performances worth 10 points each. An accumulative total ("average") of the times or score is then taken from those 3 goes to make a 4th set of points. All 4 will be placed with points from 10-1. End of the year winner = season points coming in to the finals + all points earned at the finals. Everyone will compete in his or her event 3 times.

Attention Team Ropers

Please remember: When you enter the team roping at the State Finals, your points are added to your partner's points. At that point you become a team. The top fifteen teams will be placed accordingly. You can enter with anyone you choose as long as your total points place you in the top 15.

Position Draw

We will do a random draw in Cutting, Barrels and Poles for all 3 Performances. All other events Perf # 1- Random Draw; Perf # 2 – Reverse Order; Perf # 3 - from the CURRENT places 15^{th} to 1^{st} . Be sure to check the events sheets posted each day –the places could change with each performance.

Grades

You must mail in your most current report card. For most of you it will be your 3rd quarter report card that you probably received sometime in late March. Remember you must have a 2.0 GPA in order to be eligible to compete. Submit with finals packet.
